Relationships Education and Health Education are mandatory; Sex Education and other elements of the PSHE curriculum remains non-mandatory. The three themes of 'Relationships', 'Living in the Wider World' and 'Health and Wellbeing' are repeated twice each year. Teachers draw on the needs and prior learning of their cohorts to support their lesson planning. The letter/number combinations refer to the PSHE Association Programme of Study 2020 objectives, and teachers will select these as their main teaching focus. Statutory objectives are in **bold**.
