

Messy Church is going to be starting at Diddlebury Church on Thursday 23rd May - beginning at about 3:20pm - so at the end of the school day for children at Corvedale School. Families whose children don't go to Corvedale School are welcome to join us – either when it starts or as soon as you can you can get there. It's for families – so for children with a responsible adult (parents, grandparents, carers) – this can include children who are not yet old enough to be at school. Every session will have craft activities on a particular theme for children and adults to do together – related to the time in the church year or to a particular theme from the Bible. After some time spent doing the activities, we'll join together to think about the theme with a story, a song and some prayers. After that, we'll join together to eat -ameal will have been prepared for us to eat in the church room – this will include a vegetarian option. We expect to be finishing (including the meal) by about 5pm. There is no charge for Messy Church, although we will have a plate out if you would like to make a donation towards the costs of putting it on. You don't have to book in advance either – although if you'd like to let Fr John know that you plan to come (revibeesley@gmail.com) that would give us a better idea of how many people we are cooking for and it would really help.
